Message from Commodore Wes Blazer

I hope everyone had a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year. The last two years have been strange any way you put it. Between COVID and William Shatner actually boldly going into space, it seems hard to put any label other than "strange" on 2020 and 2021. All things considered I think our membership has done a great job navigating the circumstances and had a great time around the club. Again I would like to thank PC Andy Davis for all of the work put in to make 2021 special at SSC.

2022 Budget - The board and members who joined the budget meeting approved the budget for 2022. I would like to touch on dues for 2022. The board voted to increase dues by 10% for 2022. This is the largest increase in dues I'm aware of since joining the club in 1998. We have two reasons for the increase. The first is inflation. We looked at multiple models that estimated between seven and 10 percent inflation over the next year.

The second reason is over the last few years we have taken great pains to make the club self-reliant. In years past money would be borrowed from the Sadler Basin accounts in order to cover bills for the club at the end of the year. During the past year we had repairs that were not planned crop up and needed to be addressed.

Also, we take in most of our money at the beginning of the year and we spend it as the year goes on, which leaves us with cash flow problems at the end of the year. So, we barrow money from the Basin account to keep the bills paid. We then pay Sadler back after dues money begins to come in. At this point I think it valuable to point out that we are not losing money, we are performing close to our budget. We have been closing this gap over the last few years and we are hoping this will make

a step towards the club being entirely self-sufficient. This decision was not made lightly and it was highly debated at the December board meeting. But, it's our responsibility to make sure the club continues to improve and head in the right direction. We felt it would be irresponsible not adjust for inflation.

Events - The calendar for racing is being worked out and will be set soon. We are also working on our party schedule. Look for more information to follow. I was not able to attend but, I would like to thank PC Jim Ziss and Delee for hosting the Blue Party. I understand everyone had a great time.

Race Committee - We are looking for people who are interested in becoming part of the Race Committee. If you're eager to learn, it really is a fun time. If you're interested, please don't hesitate to contact us. Also, we are looking for volunteers to help with maintenance on the race committee boats.


