It worked well last year as a test, but the process was refined this this year and credit card payments are now an option. If you did not receive yours, check your inbox for an email from mbedee@outlook.com sent on Oct. 26, 2020.

Dock payments were due Nov. 1. Keep in mind that the two-payment option has never included the 5% discount that a member gets for paying in full by Nov. 1 by check. So, to keep credit card payments simple, we are using the non-discounted dock rate (equals the 2 x half payments) and requiring it to be a full payment if paying by credit card. The non-discounted dock rate was used due to the fact that Rewards Credit Cards used to cost the club up to 12% on every dock payment if we used the 5% discounted rate for the credit card option.
