**Volunteerism** - I would like to personally thank the many members who have helped with various tasks around the club this summer. Your help in keeping up with trash, rest rooms, and the clubhouse makes everybody's experience at the club a lot nicer. Again, THANK YOU!

**Power cords** - PLEASE remember to unplug your shore power cord from the dock FIRST! Removing it from the boat first creates a disaster waiting to happen if that plug should happen to fall into the water. **Remember, Safety First!** 

For the safety and enjoyment of all berth holders, please be aware of the following when leaving your boat for the week:

- 1. Secure halyards to prevent them from slapping the mast in a breeze. It is annoying to those who sleep on their boats.
- 2. Check your spring lines to prevent the boat from crowding the main dock. Anchors hanging over the dock make it difficult to maneuver dock carts down the dock.
- 3. When returning dock carts to the parking lot, please turn them upside down to help keep them clean and dry.

*Trash* - Please deposit bags of trash from your boat in the dumpster and not the trash cans located around the clubhouse. This will help control the cost of can liners and reduce the frequency of emptying the cans. Your help with this is greatly appreciated!
