SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 ENTRIES

Competitors may enter by delivering a completed entry form with the \$40 entry fee to the Commodores Room at Sandusky Sailing Club before 2100 hrs. August 30, 2019. The race is open to beach cats and any class that has three or more boats registered.

3 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS and CHANGES TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located on front porch of The SSC Clubhouse.

3.2 Changes to the Sailing Instructions will be posted no later than 0830 Hrs. on August 31, 2019.

4 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

4.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed from the flagpole located east of the SSC Clubhouse.

4.2 If a postponement is signaled ashore, the warning signal will be made not less than 30 minutes after flag AP is lowered.

6 RACING AREA

The racing area will be the waters of Sandusky Bay and Lake Erie.

7 THE COURSE

7.1 The start will be 0.4 n. mile from the entrance of Sadler Sailing Basin on a heading of 45 degrees magnetic.

7.2 The finish will be approximately 1.0 n. mile North of the entrance to the Portage River.

7.3 Mouse Island is a mark of the course and shall be left to Port

7.4 The Course Length is 16.65 n. miles.

8 THE START

8.1 Rule 26 will apply for the start.

8.2 The class flag is a plain purple flag.

9 RECALLS

9.1 Rule 29.1 will apply.

9.2 The RC will NOT hail the name or number of OCS boats.

10 WITHDRAWING FROM THE RACE

Boats withdrawing from the race must notify the **Funday Race Chairman, Jay Austin at 330-351-0283**.

11 THE FINISH

11.1 The finish will be approximately 1Nm. North of the entrance to the Portage River.

11.2 The finish line will be between the staff on the finish boat displaying a PCYC Race Committee flag and the nearby mark.

12 SCORING

Scoring will be done using the Portsmouth Rating System.

13 OFFICIAL CLOCK

The official clock for this event will be available at registration on Friday August 30, 2019 and when scratch sheets are distributed at 0830 on August 31, 2019. Competitors should synchronize their watches with this instrument.
